Formatting an APA Paper

Elements

- x **Title Page**The title, author, and other required information should be centered about 1/3 of the way down on the page. Formal APA manuscripts includeraing header abbreviated title in all uppercase letters, placed in the top left corner of the page followed: page number in the top right hand corner. Tis information appears on all pages. Page number 1 will be on the title page. **Timenwirrg**'s headwill be included on the title page only.

In Text Citations: The Basics

- x The author and publication year osaurce must by cited in the text of your paper. One or both of these elements may be in parentheses, depending on the situation.
- x In all cases, whenever you cite somethinge in, you must include the full citation in the reference list at the end of the paper.
- x Whenever multiple elements are in the parentheses, separate them with commas. Any punctuation that the sentence requires goestsidethe parentheses. Here are some examples of correction citations for paraphrasing:

 - o Early onset results in a more persistent severe course (Kessler, 2003).
- x If you cite a specific part of a source, with or without direct quotations, theoritet quires the page number, with p. or pp. before the number. Examples:
 - Rogers (1961) has identified genuineness and transparency as two important elements of a helping relationship (p. 37).

- x APA has specific rules about citing one, two, three or more authors in the text. Examples:
 - o One author: (Butzer, 2013).
 - Two authors: (Nell & Ruggles, 2014).
 - o Three to five authors(Abdallatif, Emam, Suh, Hemaly, & Odah, 2010).
 - f Subsequently: (Abdallatif et al., 2010)
 - o Six or more authors: (Hammerschmidt et al., 2015).
- x When possible, find an original source. If you must cite a source within another source, follow these quidelines:

- x If you use a direct quotation, and the material is online or otherwise without pagination, first use the author and date format as you would with regular written sources. These the paragraph number, if available, with the abbreviationara.
